PURCHASES ON BOARD

Every passenger can open a tab at the bar and boutique. Personal expenses (beverages, snorkeling equipment, wetsuits and souvenirs not included on the cruise
contract)canbepaidonyourlastcruiseday.No consumption can be made without registering it on the bar tab with the Barman. Alcoholic drinks cannot be brought on board. We accept cash (US Dollars).

WHAT TO BRING

For the Galapagos light cotton clothing is recommended. Bring along a sweater or light jacket since it can cool off in the evenings specially during the windy season

NEW BIOSECURITY AND OPERATIONAL

Guests onboard Monserrat will be able to notice a number of additions to our cleaning regimen designed to set an even higher standard of cleanliness to the yacht. Specific areas of focus include:

SURFACE AREA AND GUEST ROOMS

COVID-19 has raised awareness about the importance of high-touch surface cleanliness. In public spaces, the Yacht has added to its already rigorous cleaning protocols, requiring that surfaces are thoroughly treated with high-grade disinfectants and that this cleaning is done with increased frequency. We will also be adding sufficient hand sanitizer dispensers all over the Monserrat's public areas. In guest rooms, the Monserrat has likewise added to its already rigorous protocols, requiring that all surfaces are thoroughly cleaned with strong disinfectant.

GRATUITIES AND TIPPING

Tipping is a frequently asked question by our passengers. This a very sensitive issue since tipping is a voluntary gift given by our passengers in recognition to the service provided by our crew. Please be aware that passengers are in no way obligated to tip our crew members since they are properly and competitively compensated by our company.

Based on past experiences on board, if service has been excellent, the average tip for the entire crew, except the guide has been of USD 15 per person per day of cruise (this amount will be divided among all the crew equally). For each naturalist guide, the average tip has been of USD 15 per person per day of cruise. Please allow for USD 24 this amount when the Monserrat is operating with 2 naturalist guides as the guide/guest ratio will drop from 16 guests per naturalist to 8-10 guests per naturalist. This will allow us to make your experience onboard more personal. Please understand this is a mere suggestion as tipping is a very personal matter.

MEAL SERVICE

Monserrat's food safety program includes enhanced sanitation guidelines for our employees that includes hygiene and disinfecting practices. All of our meals onboard will be served to the table, suspending buffet style service.

GUEST CONTACT

All our staff members will use face masks while at work. In addition, all guests will be taken their temperature when arriving onboard as well as every morning for the length of their cruise. All guests will be provided a face mask and will be mandatory to use them onboard while circulating on public areas of the Yacht.

To help alleviate the risk of transmission, Monserrat Yacht will be using signage in public areas to remind guests to maintain social distancing protocols and removing or re- arranging furniture to allow more space for distancing in the social areas. We have installed more hand sanitizing stations on the four decks of the Yacht.
