

## **YASUNI NATIONAL PARK AND LIMONCOCHA BIOLOGICAL RESERVE TOUR 5 DAYS 4 NIGHTS**

- TRAVEL DATE: APRIL 18th , 2023 RETURN TO COCA: APRIL 22rd, 2023
- DESTINATION: PASPANCHU COMMUNITIES AND YASUNI NATIONAL PARK
- ACCOMMODATION: AMAZON LODGE POMPEYA – INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY
- GUIDE NATURALIST: NATIVE INDIGENOUS GUIDE – SPEAK ENGLISH
- Accommodation: Marriage bedroom

### **DEPARTURE FROM COCA**

Our journey begins in the city of Coca in Ecuador, South America. Pick-up at the Coca airport upon arrival at 09h54, Your Guide will be Eduardo Guzman.

We go to our offices to provide you with rubber boots and rain ponchos, you will board our private canoe between 10H30 - 11h00 approximately. travel time 2h00 to 02h30. Arrival to Amazon Lodge Pilche at 13h30 approximated

### **FIRST DAY.**

– 11h00 departure from Coca, we will settle in the Amazon Lodge Paspanchu in the Pompeya sector, buffer area of the Yasuni National Park, after lunch we will visit the Limoncocha Biological Reserve, one of the conservation areas of the habitat of the black caiman, the most The largest in the Amazon, scientific name melanosuchos Niger or black caiman, the Limoncocha Biological Reserve is one of the favorite places and easy to see birds and monkeys of different species, it is a flooded forest, after visiting the lagoon we moved to the Hotel de the location  
Second Day.- 06h00 Breakfast, we will board our motorized canoe that will take us to the community of Añangu, Canopy Observation Tower at the Yasuni National Park, we Climb the 40 m. tall canopy tower where you can see the Amazon Rainforest in all its splendor until your eyes reach to canopy the majestic Amazon , as well as the mountains of the Andes, then we will visit the Parrot and parakeet clay licks, you can see parrots, macaws of different colors, with hopefully a flock of wild pig or the collare pecare species , usually this activity is successful, although the appropriate climate influences In the afternoon we will go along the Yasuni National Park path in search of large animals such as the Amazonian deer, this path is very promising for the sighting of diurnal and nocturnal terrestrial animals. Our return from this activity is estimated between 19h00 and 20h00 depending on the weather, if the weather is rainy we can return earlier than estimated. end of the third day. – Dinner

### **SECOND DAY.**

– 06 am before breakfast we will go to the lagoon in search of Birds, primates of different species and then return to breakfast, then we will visit the coffee and cocoa project with its processing, a sustainable community project, then we will go to Lunch to carry out a walk along the path of the Limoncocha lagoon observing insects, primates, butterflies, birds, snakes, amphibians, upon our return we pack our belongings and move to the banks of the Napo river bound for the Community of Pilche here we will stay in rooms with private bathroom Upon our

arrival we move to the rooms of the Amazon Lodge Pilche in the indigenous community of Pilche, where the community will receive us by inviting us to our rooms for the duration of our stay. Each comfortable room is equipped with a private bathroom, towel, toilet paper, soap, mosquito net, and a hammock area to rest after walking in the jungle. then we will go through the jungle path in search of birds, monkeys, amphibians, insects, medicinal plants and what the jungle offers us, we will arrive at a small river inside the jungle where we will have the opportunity to observe the Amazon sunset, on the way back At night we will find nocturnal birds, amphibians, nocturnal land animals such as the tapir. Upon our return dinner awaits us at the Amazon Lodge Pilche, we will rest for the next day.

### **THIRD DAY**

- After breakfast we will go along the "Mandy Forest" trail where we will paddle in the lagoon, fish for piranhas, observe alligators, with the luck of finding the fearsome anaconda and then we will return to our Hotel at night, we will take a night walk observing insects, night monkeys, amphibians, we will arrive for dinner between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. approximately. We will rest for the fourth day.

### **FOURTH DAY.**

- 06h00 Breakfast, we will board our motorized canoe that will take us to the Añangu community, Canopy Observation Tower in the Yasuni National Park, we will climb the 40 m. high canopy tower where you can see the Amazon jungle in all its splendor until your eyes reach the majestic Amazon canopy, as well as the Andes mountains, then we will visit the parrot and parakeet clay lick, you can see parrots, macaws of different colors, hopefully a herd of wild hogs or collared peccary species, usually this activity is successful, although appropriate weather plays a role In the afternoon we will walk the path of the Yasuni National Park in search of large animals such as the Amazon deer, this path is very promising for the sighting of day and night land animals. Our return from this activity is estimated between 19h00 and 20h00 depending on the weather, if the weather is rainy we can return earlier than estimated. end of the third day. - Dinner

### **FIFTH DAY.**

- Breakfast 07h00 we will visit the community center of the Indigenous to see cultural manifestations, and where you can buy local handicrafts made by the women of the community with seeds and other natural materials that they collect in the jungle. Lunch 11h00, We will serve the typical dish of the Amazon "Maito de Pescado" Back to Coca in Public Canoe, travel time 2h30 your arrival in Coca approximately at 16h00 to 17h00, where you will be taken to your hotel

### **WHAT INCLUDES:**

- Private canoe from Coca to the Limoncocha Reserve (it is possible that more people join Return,
- Private Canoe at the end of the tour from Community of Pilche to Coca

- Lodging at the Amazon Lodge Paspanchu 1 night and 3 night at the Amazon Lodge Pilche
- Hikes in the Yasuni National Park
- Equipment for Paddleboard activities
- Food during the trip
- Purified water
- Rain poncho /Rubber boots
- Local Guide Speak English
- Native Guide
- All entrances in the community of Pilche
- Pick up and Drop off in Coca.

#### **NOT INCLUDED:**

- Air fares from country of origin and between Quito and Coca.
- Food during your journey from Quito to Coca and return, breakfast in Coca on the first day or dinner on the last day,
- Lodging in Coca
- Observation Tower and lick clay parrot (US\$20 per person)
- Contribution to the Yasuni National Park Kichwa Women's Project (US\$10 per person).

#### **WHAT TO BRING ADDRESS:**

- Long sleeve shirts

- Sunscreen, Mosquito repellent

**NOTE:** The itinerary may change due to the rainy weather of the Amazon, the leader of the circuit will make the necessary changes to the activities to be carried out, if you need to repeat the activity of the visit to the parrot clay lick or the canopy tower, you must make a second payment for the tickets \$20 USD, as that refers to the indigenous culture coordinate with the leader of the circuit.
